Position – Mathematics Teacher (Full-Time)

The school is looking to appoint a full-time Mathematics Teacher with a deep understanding of the subject and a holistic approach to learning. The role commences on the 1st of January 2026. The primary role of the Mathematics Teacher will be to provide a holistic approach to learning for students across the three Phases of our school: the Lower Forms, the IGCSE and IBDP phases.

Qualifications:

- A Bachelor's Degree in Mathematics or a subject with a high proportion of Mathematics
- An Honours or Masters Degree is preferred and would be a distinct advantage
- At least 3 years IB Diploma or A-Level Mathematics teaching experience
- Professional teaching qualification e.g. PGCE
- Passion for student-centered teaching and learning and the ability to develop meaningful relationships with young people

Responsibilities

- Teach Mathematics to a diverse range of students aged 12-20 from across the world
- Teach Mathematics courses across the three Phases of the school: Lower Forms, IGCSE (including Additional Mathematics) and IBDP Mathematics (AA/AI HL/SL)
- Work with colleagues in the department to continually improve and align pedagogical approaches
- Offer support to students with Mathematics outside of the classroom, such as helping to prepare students for Mathematics Olympiads
- Contribute to student growth outside the classroom by supervising a community service activity, club and/or an co-curricular activity
- Serve as tutor to 12 students
- Perform residential duties
- Commitment to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people at the College
