

International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) results

The International Baccalaureate Diploma results for the IB Class of 2018 have been released.

Out of the 110 students who sat for the globally competitive pre-university programme, 89% were awarded a diploma. The Class of 2018 obtained an average of 31 (out of a possible 45). The highest grade in 2018 was 43 points (one candidate). 30% were awarded a Bilingual Diploma. (A summary of the results are included below).

Mr. Stephen Lowry, the school principal, applauded the students for their achievement: “Waterford Kamhlaba congratulates all the students and wishes them success in their future endeavours. We hope they will continue to embrace the values of the United World Colleges in the next stages of life. We thank everyone who supported the students and the school, in particular the teachers whose tireless efforts ensured the success of the candidates.”

For the class of 2018, the focus now switches to university applications. Already, some students have been offered places in tertiary institutions in the United States, Canada, United Kingdom and South Africa.
