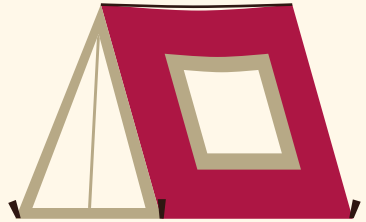
# EMBARK ON A JOURNEY.
